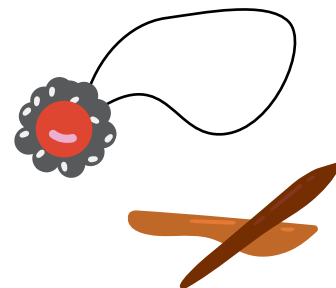


Daisies | *Kindergarten–1st Grade*

Cut and decorate a paper bracelet for a friend or family member. Make it special for them. What color might they like? Would they like some stickers or a cute drawing on it?

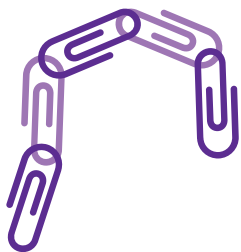
Brownies | *Grades 2–3*
